18/70 To discuss the CYC Local Plan Consultation and the Parish Council Response:

Cllrs and public discussed this matter at length

The bullet points agreed on were:

- ST27 at the end of Low Lane/Ring-road, which was safeguarded, now an area of university development
- The tracks, bridle paths and footpaths must be maintained
- Residents from Langwith Stray, Common Lane must retain their unrestricted access to the village
- The lack of details is frustrating, as the Local Plan only sets out the principles and the further information will be within planning applications
- The SSSI “Tilmire” (OS10) must be protected by agricultural land, with no infrastructure.
- Brown Field not Green Belt should be developed first.
- Any link road from A64 to the University of York must not become a “rat run”
- Concerns over further traffic congestion on local roads

The Parish Council encouraged parishioners to send individual responses.
