Meeting 11th June 2024

1. Regulation 14 document

The version circulated before the meeting which combined input from 3 working group members was discussed. It was agreed that: the flow from one section to the next was logical; not to number the sections so that there was no implied ranking; the amount of explanation of each policy was sufficient given anybody could access the full pre-submission document if they wished.

This version was accepted with minor corrections to be made. It was agreed that Mike Dando need not be involved at this point.

Action: Document to be corrected as per agreement

Document to be held pending adoption Local Plan when further amendments and addition of details of consultation dates etc will need to be made

2. Finalise Vision Statement

“Farming” had previously been amended to “agriculture”. “Village” had previously been amended to “Parish”. The bullet points related well to the sections of the Regulation 14 document and culminated in the final bullet point which reflected all of the sections.

Agreed to accept this as the final draft of the Vision Statement

3. Census figures update

These are available but do not correspond and will need explanatory notes. These will be in a separate document detailing what to change and where to insert in the main document. To be circulated and then held with the NP Master Copies by the Parish Clerk.

The intention is that all the additions, amendments and notes currently in comments alongside the master copies will be reviewed and included once the Local Plan is adopted.

The sequence of NP process is

Receive the LP -> Update the NP accordingly -> Submit HRA and SEA Screening -> CYC provide list of main body consultees e.g. coal board. We provide list local consultees i.e. all residencies and local stakeholders such as UoY -> Regulation 14 Consultation

It is hoped that the LP will be completed in the autumn following a delay while changes to Gypsy and Traveller sites was consulted on.

No further NPWG meetings will be arranged until LP adopted.
